

Working shirt guidelines for Member delegations

Overview

Members are requested to provide appropriate shirts for their accredited delegates with the approved text stating their position at the Competition. This will assist in the identification of delegate types, particularly to visitors and the media.

The approved text may be one of the following:

- WorldSkills Chief Expert or Chief Expert
- WorldSkills Expert Lead or Expert Lead
- WorldSkills Expert **or** Expert
- WorldSkills Competitor or Competitor
- WorldSkills Interpreter or Interpreter
- Team Leader
- Technical Delegate
- Technical Delegate Assistant
- Official Delegate

It is suggested that the text is printed in black or white depending on the colour of the shirt. Team colours may be taken into consideration.

The approved text, as above, shall be printed on the back of the Member uniform casual shirt using the artwork supplied. For sustainability Members may choose to not include "WorldSkills" and just have the position. This will allow for the same uniforms to be used at national, regional, and international competitions. To assist with identification of Competitors and Experts in media, the WorldSkills approved Member country or region flags are requested to be added to the left and/or right sleeves of work shirts. These should not be any wider than 8 cm.

Artwork to send to your uniform printer

The accompanying documents are the actual artwork to be supplied to your shirt printer. They have the exact wording required including the font and size to be printed. This PDF must be supplied to your printer and should not be modified or manipulated in any way – it is the exact size for consistency across all Members.

If your printer requests to reset the wording please provide these guidelines to ensure consistency:

- Font Arial Black
- Case Upper and lowercase
- Font size 92 point or 23 mm in height (capital X)



Position of approved wording

The image below shows the position of the wording on the shirts. Note that the top of the ascender on the top line of text is to be 12 cm below the collar or neckline of the shirt.
